

PUBLIC NOTICE OF RATE RIDER IMPLEMENTATION

Please be advised that the Manitoba Public Utilities Board has approved the following in its Board Order No. 108/21 issued October 4, 2021.

"That the City of Brandon, Brandon Water and Wastewater Utility, Series A debenture surcharge of \$0.083 per cubic meter, per account, per quarter, BE AND IS HEREBY APPROVED to be collected over a period of 20 years effective October 1, 2021."

On July 13, 2021, the City submitted By-Law No. 7288 to provide Series "A" borrowing amount of \$8,000,000 to cover the partial costs of works completed for upgrades to, and for the construction of a Chemical Building at the City of Brandon Water Treatment Facility. By-Law No. 7288 was read for the first time on December 7, 2020 and was given third and final reading on February 16, 2021.

Monthly and quarterly utility customers will notice this as a debenture surcharge on their October invoices. The impact on utility rates is as follows:
